

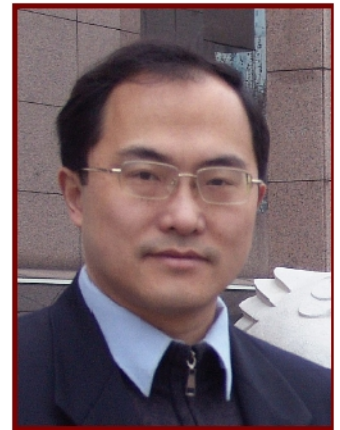

Born in May, 1962, Dr. HU Jiang is curator and director of Information & Data Center at Shanghai Museum. He is also deputy director of the Digitization Committee, the Architectural Space and New Technology Committee of Chinese Museum Association, and deputy secretary-general of the Information Committee of Chinese Society of Cultural Heritage.

Since 1999, he participated in planning and building Shanghai Museum's Comprehensive Collection Image Database and Comprehensive 3D Database (including the participation in the National Cultural Heritage Database project and Standardization and Promotional Project for Cultural Heritage Image Capturing in China); the construction and operation of Shanghai Museum's multimedia information project, cultural heritage museums' comprehensive video database; Shanghai Museum's official website (as well as the official website for the Shanghai Municipal Administrative Committee for Cultural Heritage).

Between 2006 and 2010, he participated in Construction and Exhibition Design and Planning for the Urban Footprints Pavilion and the World's Fair Museum of the EXPO 2010 in Shanghai.

I would like to run for board member of the AVICOM Committee because of a congruity of the cause and content between the AVICOM International Committee and my research fields and profession. Meanwhile, my experience and accomplishment in various Chinese committees related to information technologies give me the confidence in a new, more challenging role.

If I could become an executive member of the AVICOM Committee, I would like to join hands with colleagues in China and abroad, to provide museum professionals with the most up-to-date information of audiovisual and multimedia technologies, as well as related training and promotion; While ensuring the annual upgrading and renewal of multimedia infrastructure in Shanghai Museum, I would like to encourage Chinese museums to rise their budget in this aspect, organize studies and research in copyrights and related legal, financial matters related to Chinese museums' multimedia productions and public screening; carry out exchange between Chinese and foreign museums in terms of the development of audiovisual and multimedia database; draw the public attention to the past and knowledge related to audiovisual science and technologies and their application in museums; based on the new digital technologies used in museum artifacts exhibitions used in EXPO 2010 in Shanghai, bring new digital technologies into museum exhibitions and services; promote the influence of museum website by combining a variety of media including television, mobile phone, etc.

On the other hand, becoming an executive member of the AVICOM International Committee would also be a great opportunity for introducing Chinese audiovisual and digital technologies to the world, while at the same time learning from the past experiences of other AVICOM Committee members, contributing to the future of the committee as a member from China.

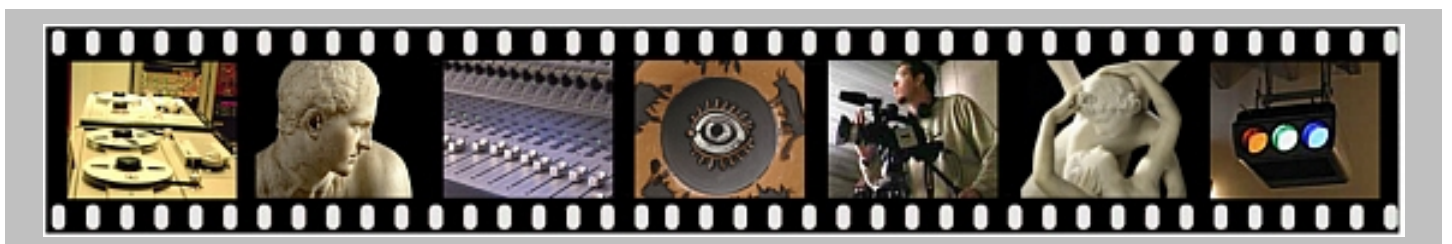
